Scholarship History



The John Hughes Memorial Scholarship was established in 1986 by the Iowa Bankers Association as a memorial for banker John Hughes from Hills, Iowa.

Hughes, a past chairman of the Iowa School of Banking Advisory Board, maintained a strong affiliation and support for the Iowa School of Banking since its origination. In his memory, two scholarships are awarded each year. These scholarships pay all room, board, and tuition expenses for recipients to attend the first-year curriculum of the Iowa School of Banking. This year the school will be held June 10-15, 2012 at the Marriott Hotel in Cedar Rapids.



Scholarship Deadline

The attached application should be filled out by the individual seeking the scholarship. All letters of recommendation and a transcript/resume should be attached and postmarked by April 13, 2012. The selected student will be notified by May 11, 2012.

About the Iowa School of Banking

Student Scholarship Criteria

The student must:

- Be attending any Iowa four-year college or university and have completed his/her junior year and interested in a career in banking upon graduation
- Be majoring in business or a related field
- Fill out the application on the reverse side, outlining qualifications, background and reasons for wanting to attend the school
- Attach a letter of recommendation from an advisor or instructor
- Attach a transcript



Media Scholarship Criteria

The individual must:

- Be an active news reporter/editor currently employed by a news organization operating in Iowa
- Have at least three years' experience as a working journalist with some background in reporting business and financial news
- Fill out the application on the reverse side, outlining qualifications, background and reasons for wanting to attend the school
- Include a letter of recommendation from a supervisor (when applicable) that includes the employer's willingness to allow the employee to attend the school
- Attach a resume
