The next step will be to have them set up with software loaded, asset tagged and prepared for the roll out to our high school students. All Washington students in grades 9-12 will be assigned their own individual computer in this fall. A committee of staff members and high school teachers have been planning this for almost two years and are very excited that it is now a reality. There will be two roll out nights in August where parents will need to sign forms checking the computers out to the students. Students will use the same computer for their remaining career at WHS. Computers will be stored at the School District during each summer where they will be updated with new software.
