

WCSD receives \$283,000 in funding!

Over the next four years, the WCSD will be receiving \$283,000 from Microsoft. The funds are from a class action lawsuit by Iowa consumers and businesses where according to the settlement a portion of the unclaimed sum would go to Iowa Schools based on free and reduced lunch rates. All 5 of our schools qualified. The funds will be used to support the implementation of the Iowa Core Curriculum. Our district is eligible for approximately \$283,000 over a four-year period. Funds will be dispersed: 50% on eligible software, 35% on eligible hardware and 15% on professional development. Only Microsoft approved items qualify for purchase. Our project includes: classroom computers, assistance with implementation of a high-speed wireless network, innovative software for writing/ publishing and professional development. The process for applying for this funding began April 2009 and the district plan was approved April 2010.
